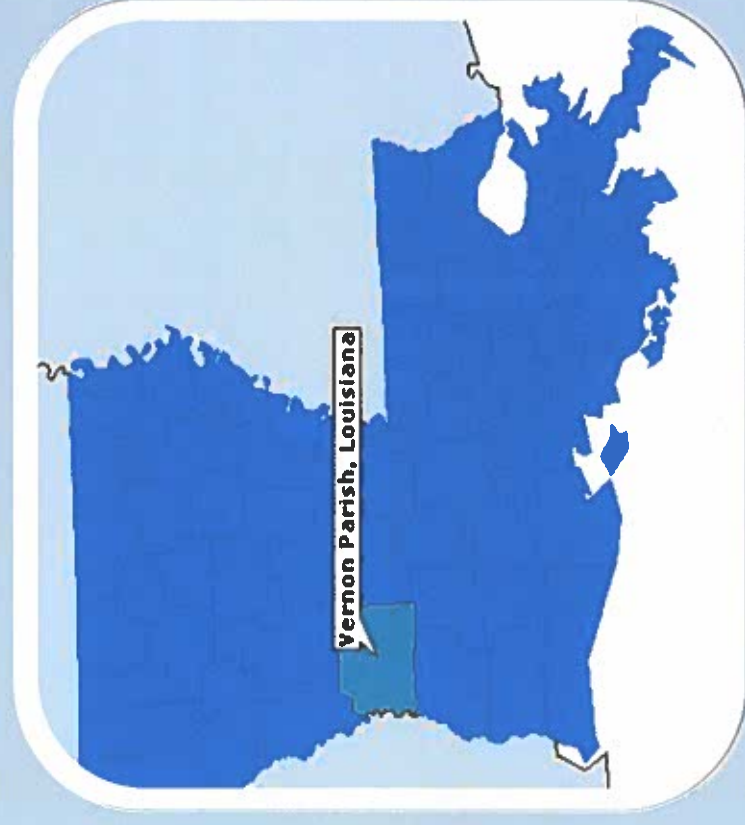

LOW-DOSE CT (LDCT) LUNG SCREENING

Are you a long term smoker? Are you at high risk?

Screening is recommended for people at high risk as part of their yearly preventive health check

Patients at high risk meet all of the following criteria:

- **Are 55 to 80 years old**
- **Are currently smoking or have quit within 15 yrs**
- **Have a smoking history of > 30 years**

Lung cancer is the leading cause of cancer death among both men and women.

COLONOSCOPY

- **Screening is the number one way you can reduce your risk for colon and rectal cancer**
- **Colon Cancer is the #2 cause of cancer death but it is one of the most preventable and if found early, most treatable forms of cancer**
- **Follow screening recommendations:**

Regular Screenings should begin for the general population at age 45 according to the American Cancer Society

Family History of colorectal cancer? Speak with your Dr. about when to begin screening

3D-MAMMOGRAM

- **Breast Screening-Early detection saves lives**
- **ALL** women **40** and older should get **annual mammograms**
- **Mammography** can lower your risk of dying of breast cancer by **40%**
- **Remember:** 75% of women with breast cancer have **NO** family history or other risk factors
- When **breast cancer** is detected early the five year survival rate is almost **100%**
